

Lake Chelan Boat Club

Meeting Minutes

April 5th, 2010

Al Steele called the meeting to order at 7:25 and again at 7:30 with the help of a big stick. The minutes from March 1st were approved as read. A short treasurer's report was read noting that the clubs assets are \$29,330. Al then introduced two guests from the Manson Parks and Recreation District, Wai Tim Peterson, Manager, and Len England, Board Member for the District.

Wai Time discussed several projects the Park is working on including the Apple Blossom Festival and improvements to Willow Point Park. Two club members brought up the need to control the erosion between the clubhouse and the park and to trim some of the trees in the park to help with boat recovery.

Al noted that the work party for the club house held on April 3rd went very well. Many club members participated and the clubhouse and grounds are in very good condition. Agencies that will be monitoring these channels and the phone (#287) include Lady of the Lake, Lady 2, Holden, the Park Service and the air service that flies to the Stehekin area. Steve will provide a *cheat sheet* on phone usage shortly. Thanks, Steve, for all your efforts on this project.

Cindy Rasmussen updated the club members about the very important Scholarship Fund project. Raffle tickets will be sold at \$5 per ticket or five for \$20. The winner will receive one Boat Winterization and a gift certificate for \$100 at Reed's Marine. The drawing will be held on August 2nd. Cindy asked that club members both buy and help sell the tickets. So, club members it's up to you to help the club raise funds for the scholarship fund. Be generous and buy lots of tickets.
